World Youth Day will be celebrated from August 1 - 6, 2023. "Mary arose and went with haste" (Lk 1:39) is the bible quote chosen by Pope Francis as the motto of the World Youth Day that will be held for the first time in the capital city of Lisbon, Portugal.

This event is a meeting of all young people from all over

the world with the Pope. A party of youth, a path, a gathering among cultures, moments of sharing and faith. During the WYD, young people will be accommodated in family houses or in public facilities and parishes. Besides the catechesis and the celebrations with the Pope, young people will participate in cultural initiatives in the city. World Youth Day will be a transforming and memorable experience.

Addressing young people in particular, and challenging them to be courageous missionaries, the following was written by the Pope in the Apostolic Exhortation Christus Vivit: "Where does Jesus send us? There are no borders, no limits: he sends us everywhere. The Gospel is for everyone, not just for some" (CV 177). The message of Pope Francis for the XXXVII World Youth Day can be found here.

Feast of the Transfiguration of Jesus

The Feast of the Transfiguration is observed on August 6 every year in the Catholic Church. This miracle revealed to Jesus' disciples that were present with Him - Peter, James and John, his heavenly glory, and is a source of encouragement for all Christians.

Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the disciples' faith in anticipation of his Passion: the ascent on to the "high mountain" - Mount Tabor, prepares for the ascent to Calvary. Though the disciples do not understand his meaning, the Transfiguration and Jesus' charge to the disciples present **a promise of what is to come**. There is hope, because he will soon triumph over sin and death, and be raised in the fullness of glory – the glory of which they have just been given a glimpse.

In 2002, <u>Pope John Paul II</u> selected the Transfiguration as one of the five Luminous Mysteries of the Holy Rosary.

PRAY FOR VOCATIONS.

August is dedicated to the "Immaculate Heart of Mary"

"The real roots of the devotion to Mary's Heart are in Scripture, where on two occasions reference is made to Mary's heart by St. Luke," points out Father Johann Roten, a Mariologist at the University of Dayton. He refers to Luke 2:19 "Mary treasured all these things and reflected on them in her heart," and Luke 2:51 "His mother (Mary) meanwhile kept all these things in memory, meaning in her heart."

He also explained, "The most beautiful biblical text about Mary's heart is the Magnificat because it reveals to us the wondrous riches of Mary's humble and regal heart. Her heart sings the praises of God, but it is not a solitary song, my song about the history of my soul, but the *Magnificat* is the song of the history of salvation for all God's people."

Our Lady continued to bring devotion to her Immaculate Heart to the forefront, next at Fatima. There, and also later to Sr. Lucia, she made several specific mentions to her Immaculate Heart.

"In our devotion to Mary's Heart there is no more effective prayer than the Rosary which is about the mysteries of her Son's life and hers. There is no better way to obtain through Mary's intercession the help we desperately need to learn how to be loving and selfless," reminded Servant of God Father John Hardon.

During August we should do something extra, something special, something extra special for Our Lady. Get enrolled in the brown scapular, wear a Miraculous Medal, begin praying the Angelus daily, or the Memorare, or why not both? Why not all? To Jesus through Mary.
