Pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate Guelph - Sat. June 21, 2025

St. John the Evangelist and St. Mary the Immaculate parishes: We may not be able to travel to Rome to see the Holy Doors but we are able to travel within our Wellington Deanery in the Hamilton Diocese. In our

Diocese there are 122 churches and Bishop Crosby has designated six pilgrimage churches – one in each Deanery. The Basilica is one of the six pilgrimage churches in the diocese.
