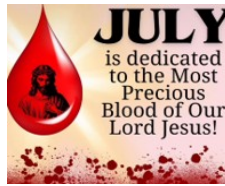

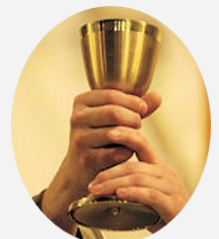

Martyr's Shrine Centennial Anniversary

100 Years of Pilgrimage : 400 Years of Mission

A century of pilgrimage, encounter and living faith!

In 2026, Martyrs' Shrine marks 100 years as a place of pilgrimage, prayer, and encounter. It also marks 400 years since the arrival of Jean de Brébeuf in Huronia, part of a mission that began long before any building stood on this hill.

The Centennial honours all who have "pushed the stone" forward across generations: Indigenous communities, missionaries, pilgrims, scholars, families, and visitors whose presence has shaped this place. This event is both a celebration and an invitation — to remember, to reflect, and to carry forward a story that continues to shape this place and those who come here.

Throughout the summer, many are expected to celebrate the centenary of Martyrs' Shrine and receive the plenary indulgence that is granted to all who devoutly visit the church and receive the sacraments. For more information: <https://martyrs-shrine.com/centennial/>
